

Since 2004, the International Summer School has offered more than 113 credit-granting courses across a wide range of topics. They are taught during June and July to undergraduate and graduate students, as well as Executive Education participants.

These courses offer a great opportunity for international students to advance knowledge in the most innovative management topics while experiencing Colombia's vibrant capital city: Bogota.

Over the past ten years the International Summer School has received over 4,000 students from different nationalities. For the most recent edition (2015), 400 students participated in courses such as Social Media & Tribal Marketing, Behavioral Economics for Business, and Positive Leadership and Organization, among others.
