CSUF will send a follow-up message to confirm, if submitted nominations may be accepted.

- After students have been admitted to the University, CSUF will mail welcome packets containing their DS2019 forms to the students' home university for distribution to the students. The welcome packets will also contain arrival and orientation details.
- The students will continue to receive follow-up pre-arrival communications from CSUF in the months leading up to their arrival.
- Please note that our office will assist with housing, HOWEVER, housing placement is not guaranteed through our office. Students are ultimately responsible for securing their individual housing arrangements.

- Prior to arrival, students will be contacted with information about how to complete the course enrollment process: course selection advice, online and in-person enrollment information, as well as the process for enrolling in courses that have prerequisites or require permission.
  - \*As with housing assistance, course enrollment advising provides students with advice and information about how to complete enrollment. Our office cannot guarantee a student's enrollment in a particular course because enrollment may depend on course availability, completed prerequisites, and/or department permission. Whenever possible, our office may facilitate course placement, if the above three conditions are met. However, partner institutions should please advise their nominated students that, with guidance from our office, they should expect to participate in the course enrollment process themselves prior to and upon arrival to CSUF.
- Students must purchase health insurance through the CSUF provider prior to arrival. There are no exceptions to this requirement.
- Our Study Abroad Team will invite your students to participate in events that help promote our exchange with your institution to the CSUF campus. These events may include the study abroad fair each semester, exchange-specific information sessions, and other similar promotional activities. It is our expectation that students will actively participate in these activities, if they do not have any class or academic conflicts. We would very much appreciate it, if you would communicate this expectation to your nominated students. Also, please feel free to engage our CSUF students in similar activities facilitated by your office.
