	to Level B2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages, as attested by the relevant certificates.
	Evidence of English Language Competence can also be provided with an official certificate issued by the Home Institution.
Minimum requirements for incoming students:	All incoming students should take a study program of 30 ECTS credits per semester. They must submit with their application an official proof of knowledge of the language taught at the Host Institution.
