	Three or four courses per semester are the average workload for full-time study, depending on the year of study and level.
Minimum requirements	It is a responsibility of the home Institution but exchange students should take at least one course.
Courses exchange students can take	Exchange students will be given access to all the courses at Bachelor and / or Master, as long as they have the necessary prerequisites and do not have time-table clashes. The Master courses are at advanced level and students should have
