BEFORE YOUR ARRIVAL





The International Student Coordinator - who will also be your main contact before, during and after your stay in Shenzhen - will send you the link and procedures to register online.

STUDENT CARD

Exchange students will be issued a student ID free of charge at International Office. The student ID allows students to use the library and other facilities on campus. For student card application please send the following documents to the email address at : wangtianyu@szu.edu.cn

Campus card will be provided under unified processing of SZU and be given to each exchange student when arrival. Please topup your student card with cash only in the E-Card Center within the campus of Shenzhen University.

VISA

All non-Chinese students who will be in China studying must apply for a student visa. A JW202 from and a offer letter will be posted to you for the application of Chinese visa. This must be done at your nearest Chinese consulate or embassy no later than 2 months before your prospective arrival date. Please also make sure that the period of validity of your passport must exceed 6 months when applying for Chinese student visa.

► ACCOMMODATION

Students can choose from several housing options, including rooms in student residencies; on-campus housing, private apartments, studios and flats.

Your coordinator will send you the document which contains useful information about on-campus. Please note that on-campus housing application must be submitted together with the Application Form for Admission of SABS.

Please use Airbnb or other formal and legal apps/websites for off-campus accommodation.

► PICK-UP SERVICE

We will also offer pick-up service in Shenzhen International Airport for Shenzhen arrival flights. Please feedback your arrival time and your flight number after you have booked your tickets.

If you are taking flight to Hongkong we will offer pick-up service in Shekou Port and Shenzhen Bay Port. After you have booked your tickets, please feedback the arrival time of your ferry/bus to Shekou Port or Shenzhen Bay Port.

SIM CARD

Discounts and tariff package Please use your student card to buy a Chinese SIM card in the China Mobile store in Shenzhen University Campus.

BANK CARD

Please use your passport and your Chinese mobile number to apply for a Chinese bank card in the Bank of China in Shenzhen University Campus. Please also ask the bank to authorize online-banking and cellphone banking for you.

► INSURANCE

International students in China are required to purchase insurance. The insurance fee is ¥300 per half a year per person. Insurance fee will be collected on enrollment day.

All Chinese student visa holders must apply for Resident Permit to the Bureau of Exit and Entry Administration within 30 days after entry.
