


AN ULTRAMODERN FACULTY ROOTED IN ITS COMMUNITY

STUDYING IN A FRENCH-SPEAKING CITY

In Québec, **96% of the population is French-speaking**, and most Quebecers also speak English. As learning French may be an asset for foreign students enrolled at FSA ULaval, they have access to business courses in French and French courses. They can also enrol in a 5-week intensive French program (July and August) and earn 6 credits.

DOUBLE MASTER'S DEGREE

We offer students the possibility of receiving 2 Master of Business Administration degrees in 2 years through **our double-degree agreements**.
