	The acceptance letter is sent once we get USJ's host faculty approval after we		
	would have received all the required documents.		
	Official transcripts of records are sent around a month after the end of each		
	semester as pdfs by email to home universities (and students are cc in the		
	email). Originals are sent by post to home universities.		
	Courses: 1 st semester courses codes end with L1, L3, L5 (BSc) and M1, M3 (MSc) while 2 nd semester courses codes end with L2, L4, L6 (BSc) and M2, M4		
	(MSC) while 2 semester courses codes end with L2, L4, L6 (BSC) and M2, M4 (MSC).		
	(MISC). Unless specified in the inter-university agreement, incoming international		
	students can take courses in different faculties but the majority of their		
	courses should be related to one main faculty.		
	The learning agreement should be finalized upon arrival and will have to be		
	sent again to the Home University for approval.		
	The language of instruction at USJ is French. Few courses are in Arabic or		
	English depending on the fields of study.
