Why Estonia?

Official name: **Republic of Estonia**

Location: **North Eastern Europe**

Capital: **Tallinn**

Area: **45,227 km²**

(larger than e.g. the Netherlands and Malta)

Climate and nature: Temperate. 50% of Estonian land is covered by forests. Estonia has over 2000 islands.

Distances from Tallinn: Helsinki 85 km, Riga 307 km, St. Petersburg 395 km, Stockholm 405 km, Vilnius 605 km

Estonian success story: Estonia produces more start-ups per head of population than any other country in Europe (Wall Street Journal). According to Enterprise Estonia, 10 to 20 new tech start-up companies are set up every year.

E-Estonia: Estonia was the first country in the world to use online political voting. Each year, around 95 percent of tax declarations in Estonia are filed electronically.

Notable people: Composer Arvo Pärt, supermodel Carmen Kass, discus thrower and Olympic winner Gerd Kanter, actress Mena Suvari and actor Johann Urb, designer Oskar Metsavaht, footballers Mart Poom and Joel Lindpere, one of the best chess players of the 20th century Paul Keres, the “father of embryology” Karl Ernst von Baer etc.

WHY EBS?

Established in 1988, EBS is the oldest privately owned business university located in the heart of Tallinn, Estonia and Helsinki, Finland. With more than 1500 students and international faculty, EBS's goal is to provide enterprising people with academic knowledge, skills and values for its successful implementation. EBS teaches entrepreneurship and business administration in a practical manner at Bachelor's, Master's and Doctoral levels.

EBS has over 70 partner universities in Europe, America, Australia and Asia, enabling a wide exchange of both students and lecturers. Over 30% of EBS's student body are international students. In 2011 EBS opened a branch in Helsinki. EBS has over 4500 alumni who according to a study by Statistics Estonia earn higher monthly income than the graduates of other Estonian universities.
