Admission Documents	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. CBA Application Form and Business Courses List to be studied at CBA/KU.2. Colored copy of the photo page of passport (validity ≥ 3 years).3. Ten <u>10</u> colored small photographs as the same size and background color of the passport photograph.4. Official University Transcript released in English Version.5. Proof of English Language Proficiency (TOEFL, IELTS, or letter from Home Institution).6. Curriculum Vitae released in English Version.7. Student ID, Blackboard and Internet Password	Incoming exchange student receives the student ID, blackboard and internet password after the courses schedule is released. It takes one (1) month to be ready after the semester starts.	
Learning Expectation	Incoming exchange student is expected to attend all lectures, complete all assignments and attend exams in order to receive a course grade.	
Internship	It is available for one semester in any of the three (3) semesters (Fall/ Spring / Summer). It is given in a three (3) credits per course and the student gets grade according to attendance of training for four (4) hours (9:00a.m. – 1:00 p.m.) scheduled for two (2) <u>or</u> three (3) days per a week. Note that the internship is unpaid.	
Work	Incoming Exchange Student is not permitted to work in Kuwait.	

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Acceptance Letter	Student receives <u>CBA acceptance letter</u> two (2) months before the start of the exchange semester.

Transcript	Incoming exchange student receives KU Transcript within one (1) month of the semester end.	
Visa	Kuwait University is responsible for the release of the student's visa. Such procedure requires a clear colored copy of the student's passport with validity \geq 3 years. A copy of the visa is sent to the student by email, while the original visa is kept with KU representative who is responsible of the student's pick-up from Kuwait International Airport. Note that visa is valid for only three (3) months.	
Health Insurance	Incoming exchange student should contact Kuwait Embassy in your home country to know the requirements and procedures of health insurance.	
Arrival Date	Student is expected to arrive one (1) day before the Orientation. Attendance is mandatory. Student confirms the selected courses or choose alternative courses if needed to be studied within the exchange semester.	
Transportation	Kuwait University provides the incoming exchange student a free pick-up and drop to and from Kuwait International Airport. Buses are free and available within KU College Campuses. Student may arrive not earlier than one (1) day prior to the orientation week for incoming exchange students. Flight Details are to be provided no later than one (1) week before the semester start by an email to SEP Office.	
Accommodation	Availability of accommodation depends on the number of the KU incoming exchange students accepted per semester. The Dormitory of Kuwait University venue is on Shuwaikh Campus. It is only 15-20 minutes from Kuwait International Airport. Student is expected to arrive one (1) day before the Orientation. Student is expected to be committed to KU Dormitory rules and regulations. Student is not allowed to spend a night out of the Dormitory. Student is expected to leave in seven (7) days of the exams end.	
Campus Facilities & Board	Student identifies CBA Campus facilities before the semester starts. The tour includes Libraries, Stationary Stores, Cafeteria, Café, Computer Labs, Music, Sport Activities, Swimming Pool, Wireless LAN, Students Clubs, Seasonal Exhibitions, Emergency Clinic and Break lounges.	
Tours	Students Exchange Office arranges tour around Kuwait once per semester accompanied by SEP coordinator in order to visit Kuwaiti Heritage and Cultural Places	
Required Documents to deliver before leaving	student is expected to answer SEP survey and write a report about the experience within the exchange semester.
